COMMERCIAL PILOT LICENSE



ABOUT

MAF Training Centre's Commercial Pilot License (CPL) course for Papua New Guinea nationals, brings specific knowledge and skills required to become a commercial pilot in PNG through a full-time, 20 month programme in conjunction with Aviation Australia.

With MAF's extensive experience in Papua New Guinea and CASA PNG approval, the MAF Training Centre offers training to an unprecedented level of industry readiness. Mareeba's ideal location, and the in-country flying blocks in PNG will teach how to navigate challenging climate, geography and weather conditions.

The training is calculated for 15 months (*full time*) towards CPL and 5 months for Instrument Rating (IR). The training will be conducted by five instructors and additional coaching will be given by a PNG instructor, with two diplomas in Aviation.

Commercial Pilot License:
January 2020 till April 2021

Multi Engine - Instrument Rating:
May 2021 till October 2021

In-country PNG experience:
Multiple blocks throughout the course

Successful completion of the course will result in a Diploma of Aviation, Commercial Pilot License-Aeroplane (AVI50215) and Diploma of Aviation, Instrument Rating (AVI50415) along with a CASA PNG and CASA Australia CPL and IR. The qualifications will be issued by Aviation Australia.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 12 High School certificate with high marks in English, Maths and Physics
- Good physical and mental health
- A suitable level of English Proficiency (*a minimum of IELTS 6.0 or equivalent rating*)
- Positive result from a 3-day assesment at the Training Centre in Mareeba, Australia

171 hours aeronautical experience, including 25 hours simulator and 70 hours pilot-in-command A\$ 81,224 (*approx. 190,000 kina*)

Additional consolidation 55 hours A\$ 21,256 (*approx. 50,000 kina*) if required***

Multi Engine - Instrument Rating:

47 hours aeronautical experience including 17 hours simulator A\$ 30,695 (*approx. 75,000 kina*)

Additional consolidation 9 hours A\$ 4,105 (*approx. 9,000 kina*) if required***

In-country Experience PNG:

Up to 40 hours pilot-in-command aeronautical experience A\$ 14,800 (*approx. 35,000 kina*)

Completion of the above three modules will ensure the best chance possible to get a job in the PNG aviation industry.
